<u>Turkey Track Fall Bluegrass Festival</u> location: Waldron, Arkansas June & October

Located in the beautiful Ouachita Mountains near Waldron, Arkansas, Turkey Track Bluegrass Park is one of the largest bluegrass festivals west of the Mississsippi. Bring the whole family and enjoy wholesome family entertainment!

There are two festivals each year (June and October). Scheduled performances are held Wednesday through Saturday of each festival.

<u>Eureka Springs Bluegrass Festival</u> location: Eureka Springs, Arkansas August

The Auditorium on Main Street in Eureka Springs, Arkansas is where many major shows and events are held each year. The auditorium stays busy with the bustling arts community in Eureka Springs. Since the early 19th century, the town has been a destination for artists and today is home to over 200 working artists and more than 20 art galleries.

Don't miss the **Ozark Folk Festival** held there each year in the fall when Ozarks artists, musicians, and craftspeople converge on Eureka Springs.
